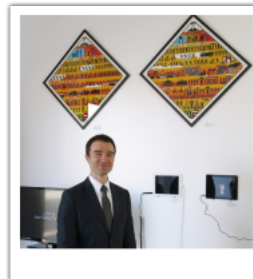
## VIRGINIE SOMMET Winner of CALL FOR BUSHWICK 2014

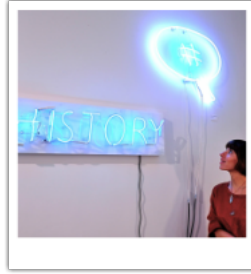
## IAN FERGUSON Winner of CALL FOR BUSHWICK 2014
