華越法藝術共治一爐 456畫廊解說「身份」

三位華、越、法藝術家正在蘇豪區
456畫廊舉行裝置藝術展覽，從各自的經
驗與體會，探討對「亞裔身份」、「男女
身份」的看法。

擁有3/4華裔血統的藝術家邱漢利
(Christiaan Kier)父母來自越南，他的作
品是用誇張大膽的自拍照，再經「Photo-
shop」數碼形象處理，把兩個自己放在同
一幅畫裏面。

邱漢利解釋說，兩個自己是代表著自
己的兩個背景，一個在亞裔父母培育下成
長的他，一個是擁有美國價值觀的他。他
從「性」、「環保」、「禮貌」等不同的
角度探討兩者之間的分別。

另一方面，邱漢利的作品還有一些是
探討亞裔族群之間，不同種族對另一個種
族的看法。

越裔陳美(Mai Tran)則以自己的背
景與經歷拍了一條短片。女主角是一個白
人，陳美說，「那是因為我即使長著一張

亞洲人的面孔，可是内心更接近白人的思
想。」

影片的背景有一個操越南語的婦女在
「嘮叨叨叨」，陳美說，那是她成長的過
程母親對她的期望。

短片從女性、性別、種族各方面來探
討這些在美國成長的亞裔第二代的思想。

法裔的蘇默(Virginie Sommet)的作
品則是裝置藝術，她從九毛九店得到靈
感，買入了很多的粉紅色娃娃與刀槍武器
玩具，拼成兩幅巨型的玩具牆。

蘇默說，「消費品對小朋友產生了很
多的不良的影響，這個作品是要向社會
作出控訴」。

她解釋說，「為甚麼女孩子一定要玩
粉紅色的玩具，這麼小的年紀就為她安排
白馬王子的幻想。這會讓女孩子長大以後
過份的依賴男人，沒有獨立自主的能力！」
男孩子的玩具也不好，「全部都是刀槍、
坦克武器，男孩子耳濡目染，長大之後難免容易動武。」

Chinese, Vietnamese and French Art in the melting pot of the Gallery 456 and their different backgrounds.

Three artists from China, Vietnam and France in SoHo at 456 Gallery. Individual experience and interpretation and explanation about identity from different backgrounds and gender.

% Chinese from the artist (Christian Kier) both parents from Vietnam. His work is exaggerated photos done with Photoshop retouching and putting himself in his work(in double). Christiaan explains that two images of himself represent him from two different backgrounds:

- 1 Under his Asian (conservative) parents influence.
- 2 Having the American mentality (consumerism).

He uses gender recycling, mannerisms and different angles of his own double background personality. And the other side of Christiaans' work shows the different Asian ethnic backgrounds and different cultures the way they look at other races.

The Vietnamese Artist (Mai Tran) uses her own past to make a short film. The main actress is a Caucasian, because she says: "I have an Asian face but my heart, my mind is closer to Caucasian culture". There is a background voice of a Vietnamese women speaking Vietnamese. It is her mother voice speaking a lot with all her expectations. The short film uses female, gender, ethnic subjects from different angles.

The movie is talking about the second generation who grew up in America.

The French Artist (Virginie Sommet) installations: she got inspiration from the 99c store and the society's stupidity. She purchases a lot pinks toys and knives, guns, toy weapons and made it in two large canvases. Virginie Sommet says that commercial products influence kids and create a lot of negative influences and this work is screaming to the society that all these toys are dangerous for the society. She shows how a young girl plays with pink toys and is manipulated since the young age with princess images and white horse fantasies.

This will make the young girl growing up over codependent of the man and not having the power of independence. Boys playing with weapons are not positive as well, everything is knives, guns, tanks, weapons and after a while the boy might be growing up being a violent person.
